

**The pediatric nephrology unit in Lund, Skåne University Hospital in southern Sweden has a job opening for a full-time pediatric nephrologist.**

The pediatric nephrology unit cares for all cases of complicated nephrology disorders in children living in southern Sweden as well as all cases of pediatric nephrology living in the vicinity of Malmö and Lund. The unit cares for close to 2000 outpatient visits and more than 800 inpatient days per year. The range of diseases is from mild to severe conditions, acute kidney injury, chronic kidney disease, chronic renal failure and transplantation. The unit carries out complicated in- and out-patient diagnostic procedures as well as dialysis including consultant support for the PICU and NICU. The team includes physicians, nurses, a dietician, psychologist, social worker, physiotherapists and play therapists. The unit has on-call responsibilities for in-patients and dialysis patients. The pediatric nephrology team has a large research facility in close proximity to the hospital. Clinical and laboratory research in pediatric nephrology is performed at the unit and the opportunity to carry out research is available and encouraged.
