

In Crescentic glomerulonephritis (CsGN) early recognition and timely intervention are required to prevent progression to chronic renal failure.

It has been reported that CsGN comprises 2-10% of the total number of kidney biopsies. The clinical and epidemiological factors of CsGN and their histopathology and outcome in the childhood are unclear and data in children are scarce. A retrospective registry of crescentic glomerulonephritis cases will be created. Data from all patients who underwent renal biopsy with histologic diagnosis of crescentic glomerulonephritis and follow up of 5-10 years will be collected. Aim of the study will be to obtain data on the etiology, clinical features, prognostic factors and long-term outcome of CsGN in pediatric patients.

For this aim a web survey will be send to all centers and accordingly invitations will be send to participate in the study

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
