In the vibrant Emma Children's Hospital (EKZ), part of Amsterdam UMC, pediatric nephrology is practiced in its full breadth. Our center is one of the three Dutch clinics performing kidney transplantation, dialysis, and (chronic) plasmapheresis in children. Additionally, we offer other extracorporeal treatments such as acute kidney replacement therapy, LDL-apheresis, and erythrocytapheresis. The Pediatric Nephrology team consists of five pediatric nephrologists and one researcher.

The Pediatric Nephrology department at EKZ operates as a functional unit within EKZ alongside the pediatric urology department, which includes four pediatric urologists. This collaboration is reflected in shared clinics and a weekly case discussion. We work closely with the Internal Medicine-Nephrology Department both clinically and scientifically, with a weekly joint nephropathology and research meetings. Our department is part of the EKZ abdominal center and collaborates with (among others) the pediatric surgery and pediatric gastroenterology departments. In addition, the Pediatric Nephrology Department of EKZ has a structural collaboration with the Pediatric Nephrology Department of UMC Groningen, where the treatment of complex patients takes place within a "shared-care" model.

The department is highly active in conducting national and international research, both clinical (medication trials) and fundamental (with two consortia, a European project on stem cells, etc.). The pediatric nephrology, pathology, immunology, and metabolic diseases laboratories form the basis of our translational research.

We are looking for an enthusiastic pediatrician, preferably with a Ph.D. degree, who is interested in a fellowship position, encompassing nephrological patient care in its full scope, as well as scientific research and providing (pediatric) education.

Part of the training will take place at UMC Groningen.
